RADM Barfield received her medical and public health degrees from Harvard University and subsequently completed a pediatrics residency at Walter Reed Army Medical Center, and a neonatal-perinatal medicine fellowship at Harvard's Joint Program in Neonatology (Brigham and Women's Hospital, Beth Israel Hospital, and Children's Hospital, Boston). She is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences and an Adjunct Assistant Professor at Emory University School of Medicine. Her research, which includes over 100 publications, focuses on maternal and infant morbidity and mortality, early child health services utilization, improving access to risk-appropriate perinatal services, and advancing the quality of women's maternal and child health data for public health action. She is a Fellow with the American Academy of Pediatrics and is the CDC liaison to the AAP Section on Perinatal Pediatrics and Committee on Fetus and Newborn. She continues her clinical work in neonatology in Atlanta, Georgia.
